Grade-Level Outcomes

This parent guide is designed to give you an “at-a-glance” look at our grade-level outcomes. These outcomes have been established by Kingspoint Christian School. More complete information is available on request.

READING/PHONICS

- Applies top to bottom; left to right; front to back when reading
- Recognizes and applies 21 consonant sounds; digraphs; two and three letter blends; short and long vowel sounds; vowel combinations
- Reads 90% of grade level Dolch word list
- Begins to orally recount details and sequences of story events
- Identifies rhymes and words that are opposites
- Fluently blends long and short vowel words
- Segments words

MATH

- Recognizes numbers 0-100
- Writes numbers 0 – 30
- Counts to 100 by 1s, 5s and 10s
- Count by 2's to 20
- Recognizes place values up to one hundred
- Applies addition and subtraction process for sums and minuends up to ten through the use of manipulatives
- Understands and applies length, weight, and quantity with regard to more or less
- Identifies eight basic shapes
- Tells time in five minute increments
- Knows value of coins

LANGUAGE ARTS

- Uses correct posture and grip; forms upper and lower case manuscript letters
- Begins writing complete sentences
- Begins to apply the three types of sentences
- Begins to use capitalization and ending punctuation
- Listens to designated speaker; follows three step directions
- Uses correct speech in front of an audience

SCIENCE

- Begins to collect and observe data
- Recognizes life cycles and stages for a variety of plants and animals
- Begins to comprehend the causes and effects of weather
- Identifies the cause of day and night
- Identifies the five senses

SOCIAL STUDIES

- Begins to comprehend God's creation of family; discusses their own family
- Identifies their role as a member of home and school
- Identifies leaders in home, school, and community
- Understands the following Holidays: Columbus Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas, MLK Jr. Day, Washington's and Lincoln's Birthday; Easter
- Begins to interpret simple maps
- Begins to understand various cultures

BIBLE

- Is introduced to God as the Creator of the universe and the Creation sequence
- Begins to understand consequences of sin and personal choices
- Introduced to a variety of Old and New Testament stories
- Begins to understand the life story of Jesus
- Is introduced to the concept of entering into a personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- Recites a Scripture verse for every letter of the alphabet and Psalm 100
